



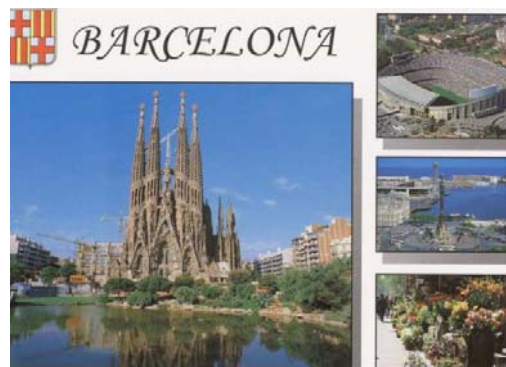
# THE BARCELONA CUP – JULY 6 / 11, 2009
